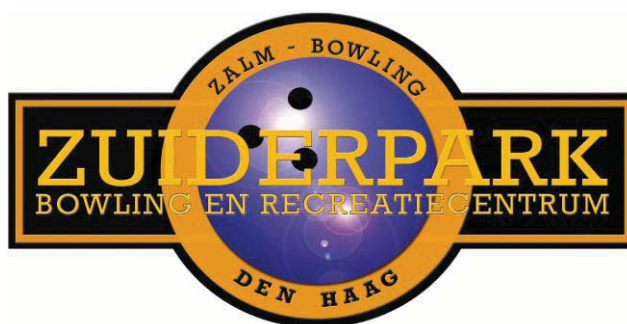

- * This tournament is open to all members with a bowling license and an FIQ pupils and/or junior status up to 21 years.

With a supplement of Participation to this tournament for all NBG members and members with a FIQ licence in the age category of 22 til 25 years old.

- * The tournament has been approved by the Dutch National Bowling Federation (NBF) under tournament number **2012/A021**



FORMAT

Preliminaries, all competitors play, at least, 6 qualifying games.

Category 0 plays 8 preliminary games, American style / 2 players per lane

Category 1 plays 8 preliminary games, American style / 2 players per lane

Category 2 plays 8 preliminary games, American style / 2 players per lane

Category 3 plays 7 preliminary games, American style / 2 players per lane

Category 4 plays 6 preliminary games, American style / 2 players per lane

The first 6 games of the highest preliminary games are taken into account for the YET

- * **For the finals (group 3 and 4) and/or semi finals (group 0 - 1 and 2), minimum 3 or maximum 8 are qualified, after the preliminaries.**
- * If, in a category, there are more than 32 competitors, which means that there will be more than 8 players for the finals or semi finals, according to the 25 % of the NBF rules, these players (as from n° 9) will receive their prize immediately after the preliminaries.

Players number 1 till 8 (depending on the number of participants per category) play the finals, respectively the semi finals, depending on the category they are playing in.

- * Scores from the preliminary rounds of category 3 & 4 are carried forward to the finals. Scores from the preliminary rounds are not carried forward to the semi finals Round R.

- * **Knockdown final** for the top 3 or 4 for the categories 0, 1 & 2 (depends on the number of participants per category).

N° 3 plays against n° 2: 1 game, the winner continues, and plays against n°1 "the best of three games"

or

N° 4 plays against n° 3: 1 game, the winner continues, and plays 1 game against n° 2, the winner continues, and plays against n° 1 "the best of three games"

Remarks: for Youth A-tournament

For the group 175 + girls and 185 + boys. When there are less than 12 competitors in this group, then the minimum prize based on 12 competitors will apply.

- * Players at the age of 18 til 21 who are senior member according to the NBF licence can only be subscribed in category 1 & 2.
- * The average listed on the valid 2010/2011 bowling pass, is decisive. If no average is mentioned on the pass, an official statement must be presented, in which the average over at least 36 games is listed. This statement should not be older than a fortnight.
- * If no average can be shown, the player will be placed in the top division. Players who want to play in a higher class, should this before the registration. During the tournament, this is not possible, because of the determining of the final number of places per class.

But be careful:



Only 1 RE-ENTRY is permitted

If you think you did not play well enough during your 1st entry, it is possible to make a re-entry!

Equal opportunities to retain is the price for the re-entry very attractive. Of course also in the interest of the charity for which we play this year.

The highest scores go along for placement finals or semifinals.

- * For the Dutch participants, the scores of the two rounds (if played) will be passed to the NBF.
- * Re-entry is permitted in the different rounds as long as there is space, being open spots.
- * If you choose in advance to do a re-entry, you report it at registration and you also pay in advance. If, after the first heat (because that your score is high enough) you decide not to do a re-entry you will receive no refund. The money is already due to Cystic Fibrosis, Dutch Burns Foundation and Leukaemia Foundation. Three possibilities that you can vote for when you subscribe. The organization that receive the most votes will receive the funds.
- * YOU are in the fortunate position that you can make this choice. Other children can not. Or yet. Because they have a disease which may or may not been patched. For the latter, finding a solution, we support them a little by a: make the price of the re-entry attractive to everybody. And b: these revenues are not used for the prizemoney but after the tournament it will be donated to one of these organizations. As an organization we believe that we can make more children happy than to make the bowlers themselves.

- * Obviously, during the tournament you are always welcome to donate some extra money. We will provide a special box for this purpose. All initiatives to increase the gifts are more than welcome.
- * When a tie occurs, article 218, paragraph 3c of the NBF rules will apply.
- * Bowling clothing is obligatory, both during the match as well as during the prize giving ceremony. You are not allowed to wear shorts, hats, caps, etc.
- * Competitors are requested to report to the tournament desk half an hour before the start of their squad or, if applicable, the finals.



SLOW BOWLING

In order to prevent unnecessary delays in the time schedule, players are expected to be on the approach and ready for their turn within 30 seconds after the preceding player has left the lane.

By non-compliance to this rule we will apply the NBF sanction with art. 225, 3 and art 241.

OIL PATTERN

As known, also the tournament also part of the European Youth Trophy-YET. This means that a pattern match in the tournament will be established which of course can be played by everyone but which is also challenge. So scoring with "two fingers in the nose" is not immediately obvious. But the headline here "concentration" is sure to score.

The Pattern will be announced in advance.



PRIZE CEREMONY approximately 19h30

All entries received before January 15th 2012 will be confirmed in writing or by E-mail . Everyone who has registered, is obliged to pay the entry fee at all times.

In case of any dispute not covered by these rules, the tournament organisation will take a



Prize fund for the numbers 1 through 3

The total prize money depends on the turnout and is guaranteed as of 12 competitors per group (see below). The minimum prize fund based on 12 competitors, is increased with every 4 additional competitors. This increase is applicable up to 28 players per group. The maximum guaranteed prize fund is reached with 28 players.

Explanation:

The prize fund is financed as follows. From the entry fee we deduct only € 7.50 for mandatory expenses. The rest goes directly into the prize fund. As mentioned above, the total prize fund per group will depend on the number of competitors playing. For example: group 3, entry fee € 20,00; we deduct € 7,50 which leaves € 12,50 for the prize fund. In case of 18 competitors this will result in 18 x € 12,50 which is € 225, = prize money. 25% of the 18 competitors goes to the finals, which in this example would mean 5 finalists. Prize breakdown: the winner receives 30%, the runner-up 25%, the number three 20% and the other finalists get their entry fee refunded. Summarizing, this means that 12 players guarantees minimum and 28 maximum prize money. See the list below for a minimum or maximum per group.

In order to obtain the maximum prize money you need 28 players in each group. If entries in your group are low, you can help build up the prize money by encouraging more bowling friends to play the tournament.

Exception: If group 1 has less than 12 competitors, the minimum prize money in this group will be paid none the less. The loss will be taken by the organising committee.
